**Dr Wolfgang Schäuble** was a Barrister at Offenburg Regional Court from 1978 to 1984. From 1981 to 1984 he served as a Parliamentary Secretary of the CDU/CSU Parliamentary Group in the German Bundestag.

From 1984 to 1989 Dr Schäuble served as a Federal Minister for Special Tasks and Head of the Federal Chancellery. He serves as a Member of Board of Governors at European Investment Bank, The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development since 28 March 1991.

He studied law and economics at the universities of Freiburg and Hamburg and has served as Germany's Federal Minister of Finance in the second and third Merkel cabinets since 2009. He is a strong supporter of EU integration and has taken tough stance on the UK on issues of tax breaks and exit costs stemming from Brexit. Dr Schäuble is more liberal on immigration issues, having previously argued vehemently for open border policies in the EU.
